Purpose of this Meeting:

- This meeting is to determine which volunteers, street outreach, street ministries and service providers, hereinafter referred to as HELPERS are willing to start working together to help solve some of the problems of the homeless. We need to join forces on some level and start working on some short-term solutions for our homeless friends and neighbors. Better communication and the sharing of information, experiences and resources, are the keys to help get the homeless off the streets.
